**THE COURT ORDERS THAT:**

1. Pursuant to s 439A(6) of the *Corporations Act* 2001 (**Act**), the convening period defined in s 439A(5)(b) of the Act in respect of:
  - (a) Specialised Concrete Pumping Victoria Pty Ltd (ACN 153 660 827) (Administrators Appointed);
  - (b) TKS Titan Pty Ltd (ACN 126 037 401) (Administrators Appointed);
  - (c) TKS Enterprises Pty Ltd (ACN 089 747 320) (Administrators Appointed);
  - (d) QJV Pty Ltd (ACN 117 896 723) (Administrators Appointed);
  - (e) Meales Concrete Pumping & Placing (Qld) Pty Ltd (ACN 104 264 039) (Administrators Appointed);
  - (f) Meales Concrete Pumping Pty Ltd (ACN 103 969 900) (Administrators Appointed);
  - (g) Project Civil Pty Ltd (ACN 111 269 366) (Administrators Appointed);
  - (h) Gladstone Concrete Pumping Pty Ltd (ACN 113 822 996) (Administrators Appointed);
  - (i) Contractor Services (Queensland) Pty Ltd (ACN 165 755 644) (Administrators Appointed);



- (j) Pump Corp High Rise Pty Ltd (ACN 166 502 236) (Administrators Appointed);
  - (k) Pump Corp Concrete Pumping Pty Ltd (ACN 169 010 664) (Administrators Appointed);
  - (l) MCP (Qld) Pty Ltd (ACN 120 413 676) (Administrators Appointed);
  - (m) Specialised Concrete Pumping Pty Ltd (ACN 009 330 303) (Administrators Appointed); and
  - (n) Meales Concrete Pumping (NT) Pty Ltd (ACN 156 308 717) (Administrators Appointed) (collectively **Companies**),
- be extended to midnight on 1 April 2016.
2. Pursuant to s 447A(1) of the Act, Part 5.3A of the Act is to operate in relation to each of the Companies as if the meeting of creditors of each of the Companies required by s 439A of the Act may be held at any time during the period comprising the convening period as extended by paragraph 1 above and the period of five business days thereafter, notwithstanding the provisions of s 439A(2) of the Act.
  3. Liberty is granted to the Plaintiffs to apply for a further extension of the convening period referred to in paragraph 1 above at any time prior to 1 April 2016.
  4. Any person having a sufficient interest may apply to the Court for an order discharging or varying any of the orders made in paragraphs 1 or 2 above.
  5. By 1 March 2016, the Plaintiffs give notice of this Order to the Companies' creditors by:
    - (a) uploading a copy of this Order onto the website <http://www.grantthornton.com.au>; and
    - (b) sending a circular letter to each of the Companies' creditors (by email in respect of those creditors who have informed the Plaintiffs that their email is their preferred method of communication, and by post in respect of all other known creditors) informing them of the substance of this Order.
  6. The Plaintiffs' costs of the application are costs in the administration of the Companies.

Subsection 35A (5) of the *Federal Court of Australia Act 1976* (the *Act*) provides that a party to proceedings in which a Registrar has exercised any of the powers of the Court under subsection 35A (1) of the Act may, within the time prescribed by the Rules of Court, or within any further time allowed in accordance with the Rules of Court, apply to the Court to review that exercise of power.

Rule 3.11 provides that a party may apply to the Court under subsection 35A (5) of the Act for review of the exercise of a power of the Court by a Registrar and that any application must be made within 21 days after the day on which the power was exercised. A party seeking a review can apply to the Court to dispense with any requirement of the Rules (Rule1.34).
